

How much is your electric bill? *YOU decide!*

Time-of-Use Rate

If you can control the time of day that you consume energy, this may help you save money.

Our Time-of-Use (TOU) electric rate encourages you to reduce your electric use during peak periods, potentially lowering your annual energy costs — without reducing the overall amount of electricity you use.

You could save as much as 15% per month on your electric bill by using large appliances during the times of day when there's low demand for electricity. Most likely, changes in your household's energy use routine will be necessary.

TOU can be as easy as doing a couple of loads of laundry later in the evening or on Saturday morning. It may be as simple as using programmable thermostats or setting timers on appliances. When you opt to use a greater amount of electricity during hours when power is less costly to produce, we pass along the savings to you.

The samples included are based on an average 1,500 kwh bill. The more electricity you consume, the greater your opportunity to benefit from this program.

SAMPLE A: Standard Residential		1,500 total kwh
1,500 kwh used	=	\$134.06
Consumer Charge	=	24.17
Total	=	\$158.23

**On Peak = 11am-7pm Monday thru Friday
Excludes Holidays and Weekends**

SAMPLE B: TOU8 (50% change on-peak usage)		1,500 total kwh
1305 kwh used off-peak	=	\$83.52
195 kwh used on-peak	=	\$28.82
Consumer Charge	=	\$34.00
Total	=	\$146.34

**On Peak = 4-7pm Monday thru Friday
Excludes Holidays and Weekends**

SAMPLE C: TOU3 (50% change on-peak usage)		1,500 total kwh
1426 kwh used off-peak	=	\$91.26
74 kwh used on-peak	=	\$19.76
Consumer Charge	=	\$34.00
Total	=	\$145.02

Totals Exclude Sales Tax.
